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Introduction

The *Consideration* Evaluation module allows you to score ideas and decide on the most valuable to action and implement. It is a customizable decision matrix that allows administrators and moderators to identify the most valuable ideas in line with company objects.

Administrators and Moderators are able to define:


- Weighted business goals
- Variable Cost structures
- ▶ Potential business constraints and more.

Creating a new evaluation

Click on the "Create Evaluation" link within the "Idea Evaluation" tab:



The first step is to enter the "Basic Information" which consists of:

Evaluation Title: Simply enter name of evaluation


Evaluation Description/Background: Enter a short background. This will display as an instruction / welcome text to chosen evaluators when they login.

Custom welcome text: For value, cost and constraints, we display default text. This can of course be changed if required.




Evaluation dates: Enter the dates on which the evaluation can take place. Note: reports can only be viewed after the evaluation end date.

Selecting an Idea for evaluation: You can use the filters for "Filter within Challenge" and "Filter by Status" to locate your idea you wish to evaluate.




The 2nd tab allows you to add Weights and enter custom names for each component. There are three general criteria involved in the evaluation: **Value, Cost and Constraints**. Add a weight for each in order to show relative importance attached to each.




The importance of the number 10


The total value of weighting must come to ten (10). Both is the case of the elements AND in the key components of value, cost and constraint.




The 3rd tab allows you to customize the "Email Template" which is sent after you assign your review team.




The 4th and final tab will display a list of moderators which can be assigned to evaluate the selected idea. Ticking the box next to their name and click on the "Assign" button:




The assigned moderators will be sent the following email: (from where they can click on the link to be taken straight to the evaluation scorecard)



Reviewers are first greeted with a custom welcome message, introducing the review and inviting them to rate the idea based on their specific area of expertise:




They respond by selecting **High**, **Medium** or **Low** according to the idea's high, medium or low impact on each of the cost factors listed.




The evaluator receives a thank you message after successfully completing the evaluation scorecard.

Running your evaluation report

Click on the "Activity Reports" link from the left menu tab "Idea Evaluation."



A list of the <u>completed</u> evaluations will be displayed.




Clicking on the "score" hyperlink will open the following popup. Showing the breakdown and detail of the 3 elements (scored by each assigned evaluator)



Evaluation Templates


Sometimes you might want to use the same evaluation card on multiple ideas. You can create an evaluation template, and save it, ready to be used for existing and future Ideas.

You create the template in the usual way:



Once your template is complete, you can assign ideas to it using the gear dropdown:

Search for the idea, tick its checkbox, then click 'Assign Selected Idea'. You can also assign Challenges, using the same method.
